TEACHERS' CORNER

UNSUNG HEROES OF INDIA: A TRIBUTE TO HIDDEN WARRIORS

India's struggle for independence was shaped not just by the well-known but also by countless unsung heroes whose bravery, sacrifice, and determination often went unnoticed. These individuals fought against British oppression through revolts, revolutionary activities, social reforms, and grassroots movements. Their stories, though not always highlighted in textbooks, are a testament to the spirit of resilience and patriotism that defined India's freedom movement.

From fearless queens like Rani Durgavati to young revolutionaries like Khudiram Bose, and from scholars like Lala Lajpat Rai to warriors like Chandrashekhar Azad, each of them played a vital role in shaping the destiny of the nation. Their sacrifices remind us that freedom was not a gift—it was earned through courage, struggle, and unwavering faith in justice.

This edition makes students aware of these heroes and gives tribute to those hidden warriors whose legacy continues to inspire generation. From the next edition, we will try give a detailed look at the heroes.

Rani Durgavati (1524–1564)

Known as the "Jansis of Gondwana," she was a fearless queen who defended her kingdom against the Mughal invasion with bravery and strategic warfare.

Mangal Pandey (1827–1857)

A soldier in the British East India Company, his act of rebellion in 1857 sparked the first war of Indian independence, though his role is often overshadowed by later leaders.

Lala Lajpat Rai (1865–1928)

A prominent freedom fighter, he played a crucial role in the struggle for independence and was a key figure in the Non-Cooperation Movement.

Bengal's 'Father of the Revolution' – Khudiram Bose (1889–1908)

A young revolutionary who became the youngest martyr in the freedom movement, his courage in the face of British oppression was remarkable.

Veer Savarkar (1883–1966)

A freedom fighter, poet, and politician, he was a fierce advocate for Hindutva and played a crucial role in the independence movement, though his legacy remains controversial.

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel (1875–1950)

Known as the "Iron Man of India," he united over 500 princely states into the Indian Union, but his contributions are often overshadowed by Nehru and Gandhi.

Chandrashekhar Azad (1906–1931)

A revolutionary who vowed never to be captured by the British, he was a key leader of the Hindustan Socialist Republican Association (HSRA) and died fighting for India's freedom.

Bipin Chandra Pal (1858–1932)

A nationalist leader who promoted the idea of "self-reliance" and played a key role in the Swadeshi Movement, his contributions are often forgotten.



TEACHERS' CORNER

UNSUNG HEROES OF INDIA: A TRIBUTE TO HIDDEN WARRIORS

Aruna Asaf Ali (1909–1996)

A freedom fighter and social reformer, she played a key role in the Quit India Movement and was the first woman to hoist the Indian National Flag at the Red Fort.

Subhas Chandra Bose (1897–1945)

Though not exactly unsung, his leadership in the Indian National Army and his defiance of British rule were pivotal. His legacy is still debated, but his impact was immense.

Sarojini Naidu (1879–1949)

Known as the "Nightingale of India," she was a freedom fighter, poet, and the first female governor of an Indian state. She played a crucial role in the Civil Disobedience Movement and Quit India Movement.

Dadaji Kondadev (1854–1918)

An educationist and social reformer, he was a mentor to Bal Gangadhar Tilak and played a significant role in the Indian freedom movement, emphasizing the importance of education.

Tantia Bhau (1830–1858)

A lesser-known freedom fighter who fought bravely in the 1857 rebellion. He was a key figure in the resistance against the British in Central India.

Gopi Arjan (1910–1946)

A revolutionary from Punjab, he was part of the Ghadar Party, which aimed to overthrow British rule through armed struggle. His bravery during the freedom movement remains largely unrecognized.

Potti Sriramulu (1901–1952)

He fasted to death for the creation of the state of Andhra Pradesh, sacrificing his life for the cause of regional identity and linguistic unity.

Ram Prasad Bismil (1897–1927)

A revolutionary poet and freedom fighter, he was involved in the Kakori Train Robbery, an act aimed at funding the struggle against the British.

Ramesh Chandra Dutta (1872–1938)

A historian and freedom fighter, he worked tirelessly to document India's history and was a part of the Indian National Congress, contributing to the national movement.

Aurobindo Ghosh (1872–1950)

A philosopher, poet, and freedom fighter, he was a key figure in the early stages of the Indian independence movement and later became a spiritual leader.



TEACHERS' CORNER

SANSKAR

In today's time, it is very important to give values to children and it starts from our home. Children should always be motivated to do good deeds. Only then they grow up to become good people. A folk tale related to 'sanskars' is popular. According to this tale, in ancient times a saint was begging alms in a village with his disciple. During this time he reached outside a house. When he called for alms, a little girl came out from inside. The girl told the saint that we have nothing to give you.

The saint said, daughter, don't refuse, if you don't have anything then donate some soil from your courtyard. The saint explained to the disciple that today that girl is small and if she learns to refuse from now on, then even after growing up she will not donate to anyone. Today she has donated a little soil, this will awaken the feeling of giving donation in her mind. In the future when she grows up and becomes capable, she will donate fruits, flowers and money too and will also help helpless people.

The message of this story is that children should be taught to do good deeds, they should be given good values. If we inspire them to do good deeds from childhood, they will become good people when they grow up and will stay away from evil.
