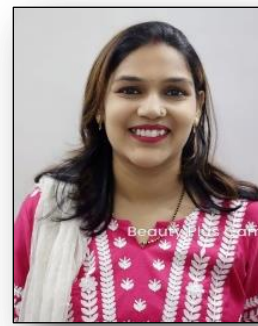

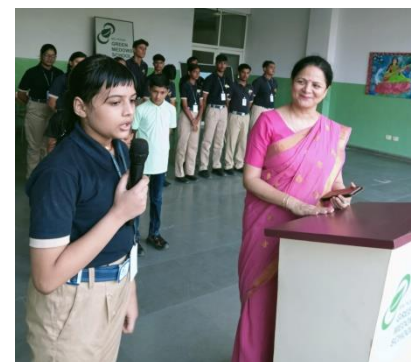
ASSEMBLIES

GANDHI JI & LAL BAHADUR SHASTRI JI'S JAYANTI

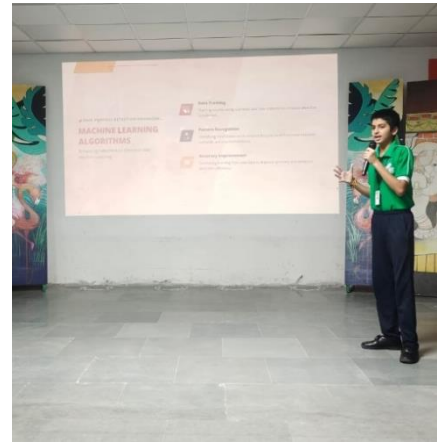

DIYA DECORATION, KANDEEL AND BANDHANWAR MAKING

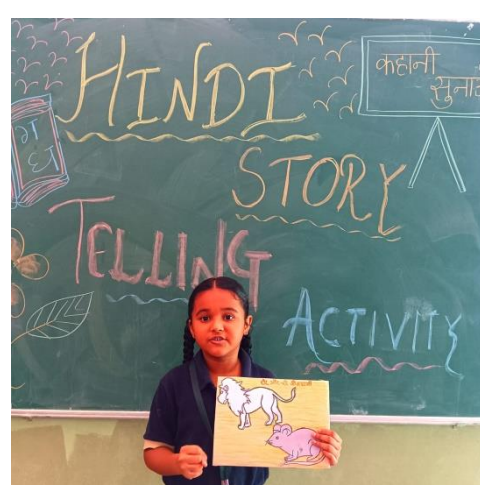
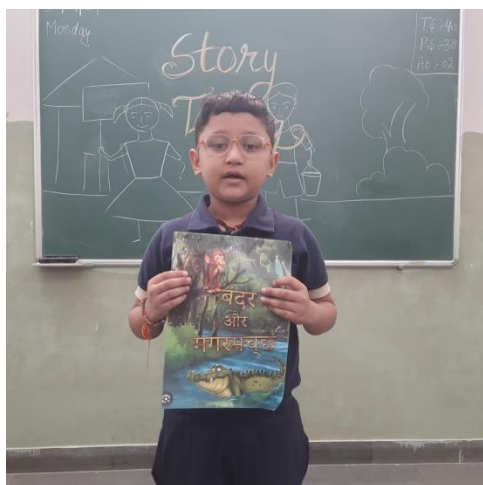

BEST OUT OF WASTE: I - II

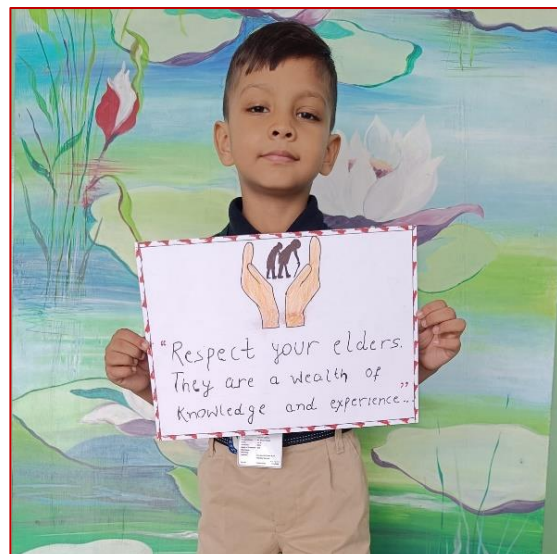
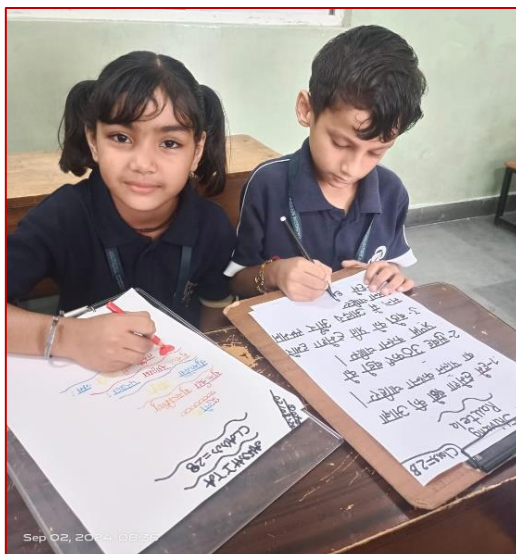

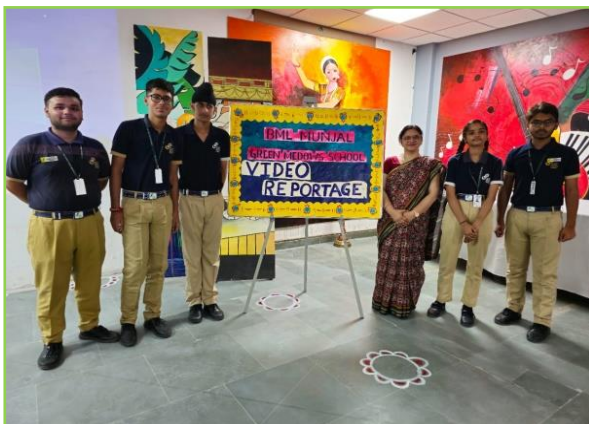

Sometimes life surprises us with unexpected twists and turns, but that's where the magic happens. We discover strengths we never knew we had, and our journey becomes more meaningful.

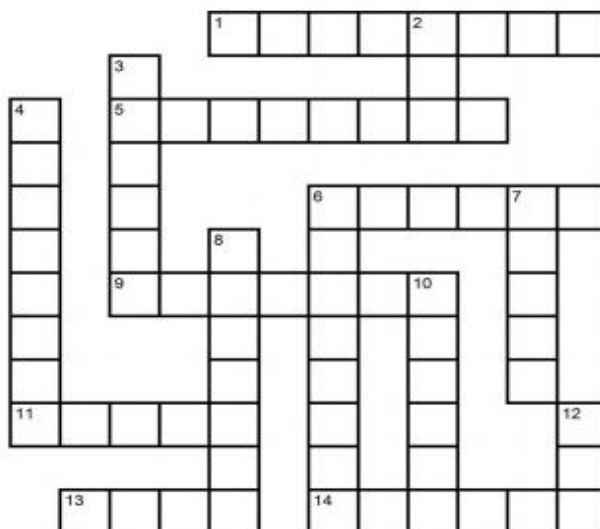

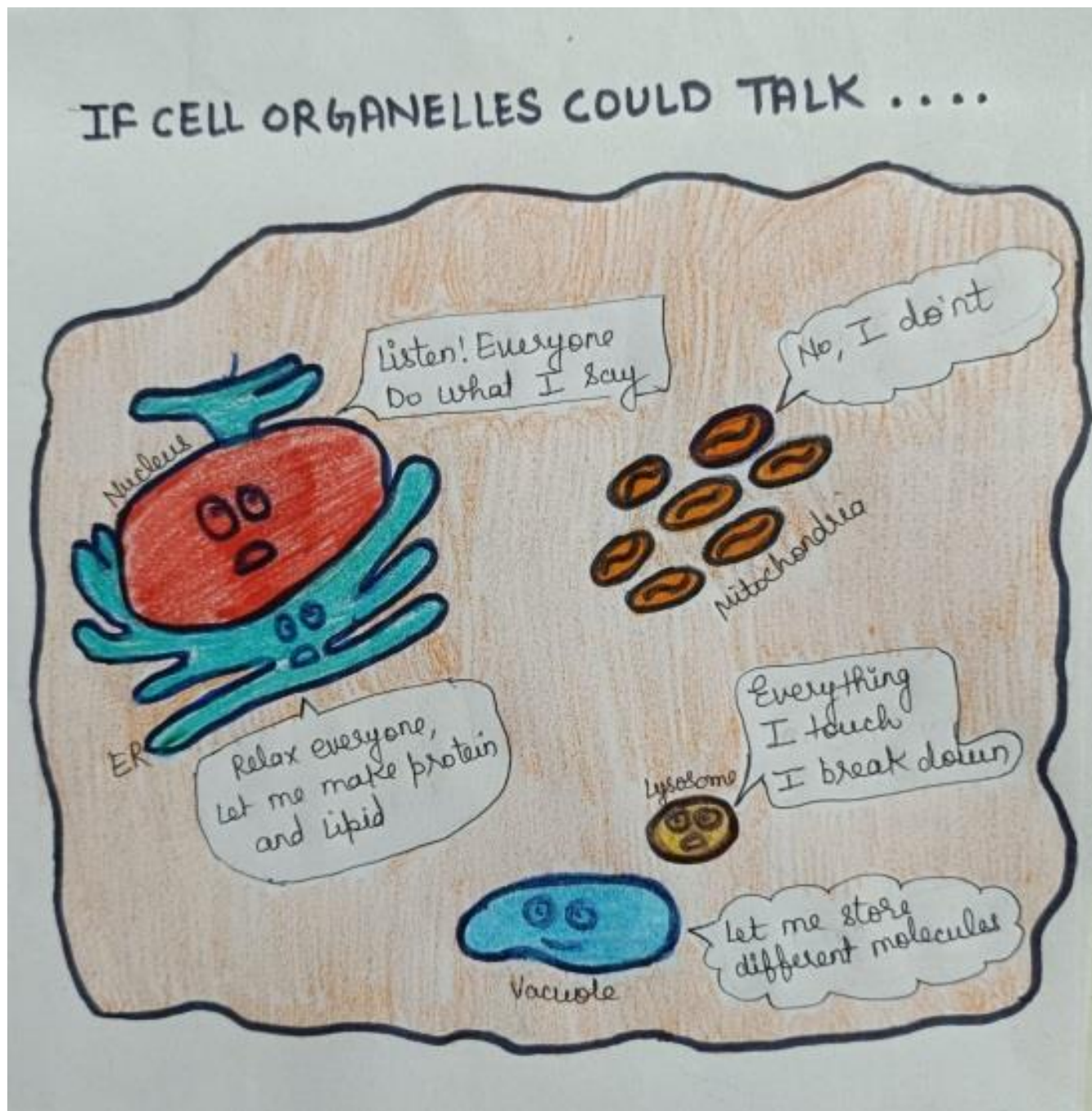

सृष्टि का सार तत्व

इस ब्रह्माण्ड की आत्मा ईश्वर है- *अहम् आत्मा गुडकेश सर्वभूतसया स्थितः* -वस्तुओं का सार स्वयं ईश्वर है। जैसा कि वैज्ञानिक हमें बताते हैं, वस्तुओं का सार परमाणु और इलेक्ट्रॉन नहीं हैं, बल्कि ईश्वर की महिमा ही सभी वस्तुओं का सार है। विद्युत ऊर्जा ब्रह्माण्ड का घटक नहीं है। क्वांटम कण या प्रकाश की तरंगें सृष्टि का सार नहीं हैं। स्थान के अस्तित्व की काल समन्वय और ऊर्जा का सातत्य सृष्टि का सार नहीं है। ईश्वर आध्यात्मिक बाढ़, जो विभिन्न तीव्रताओं में *अवतार विभूति* के रूप में प्रकट होती है, सृष्टि का सार है। ईश्वर स्वयं सृष्टि है, और इसलिए ईश्वर ने संसार की रचना नहीं की है। जैसा कि धीरे-धीरे बताया-वे इस संसार के रूप में प्रकट हुए हैं। यह वही है जो हमें धीरे-धीरे, जिससे हम हैरान हो जाएंगे। *अहम् आत्मा*: भगवद्गीता कहती है - "मैं सभी प्राणियों की आत्मा हूँ। हम जानते हैं" कि 'आत्मा' का क्या अर्थ है। आत्मा वह सब कुछ है जो किसी भी चीज़ में अर्थ रखता है। किसी चीज़ की आत्मा के बिना, वह चीज़ बिल्कुल भी अस्तित्व में नहीं रहती। किसी भी चीज़ को उसके सार से अलग करके हम उसे उसकी आत्मा से मुक्त कर रहे हैं, जिसका मतलब है कि हम उसे उसके अस्तित्व से ही मुक्त कर रहे हैं। किसी भी चीज़ के अस्तित्व को ही उस चीज़ की 'आत्मा' कहा जाता है, और इसलिए जब यह कहा जाता है कि ईश्वर सभी चीज़ों की आत्मा है, तो इसका मतलब है कि हर चीज़ का अस्तित्व ईश्वर है, और ईश्वर के बिना सब कुछ शून्य है। जब ईश्वर सृष्टि के सार से मुक्त हो जाता है, तो हमारे सामने एक शून्यता, एक पूर्ण शून्यता होती है।

ईश्वर के बाहर कोई संसार नहीं है, और इसलिए संसार उसके बाहर मौजूद नहीं है। लेकिन यह एक कठिन अवधारणा है, इसलिए हमें एक अधिक विशिष्ट विवरण दिया गया है जिसे मन अधिक आसानी से समझ सकता है, बजाय इसके कि जब उसे ईश्वर की इस अद्भुत वास्तविकता के साथ प्रस्तुत किया जाता है कि वह सभी चीज़ों का योग और पदार्थ है, सभी चीज़ों का अस्तित्व है। हमें बताया गया है कि वह निर्माता, संरक्षक और संहारक है - *अहम् आदि च मध्यम च भूतं अंत एव च*। इसलिए हम थोड़ा सा सांत्वना पाते हैं: जब हमें बताया जाता है कि ईश्वर सभी चीज़ों का निर्माता, संरक्षक और परिवर्तक है, तो हम सृष्टि की एक कम परिभाषा और अधिक स्वीकार्य विवरण पर आ जाते हैं, जबकि हमें बताया जाता है कि वह सभी चीज़ों का अस्तित्व है। शुरुआत में यह कहा गया है कि ईश्वर आत्मा, योग और पदार्थ, सार, अस्तित्व और सभी में सब कुछ है जो - सभी चीज़ों का *आत्मत्व* है। साथ ही यह भी बताया गया है कि वह सभी चीज़ों का सृजक, प्रवर्तक, पालनकर्ता और संहारक है। हमारे लिए इसकी कल्पना करना भी कठिन है। यह सृष्टि क्या है, यह पोषण क्या है और यह प्रलय क्या है, ब्रह्मांडीय दृष्टि से सा मरिक्क इन विचारों -हमारा छोटा - को धारण नहीं कर सकता।

अतः हमें विशेष महिमाएँ बताई गई हैं- *आदित्यानां अहम् विष्णुः*। इस संसार में जो कुछ भी परम श्रेष्ठ है....., उसे भगवान की किरण मानना चाहिए। गीता का संपूर्ण दशम अध्याय इसी विशेष महिमा का वर्णन है। जहाँ कहीं भी अभिव्यक्ति का उल्लास है, चाहे वह अभिव्यक्ति किसी भी प्रकार की हो उसे भी भगवान की उत्कृष्ट विभूति मानना-भी प्रलय हो या बाढ़ चाहे वह कोई-चाहिए। अभिव्यक्ति की यह श्रेष्ठता या आवश्यक रूप से हमारे सामने एक सुंदर और मनोरम दृश्य ही नहीं है। किसी भी प्रकार की प्रलयकारी श्रेष्ठता, जो स्वीकार्य हो या भयावह किसी भी प्रकार से - अभिव्यक्ति मानना उसे भगवान की चाहिए। हमें यह भी बताया जाएगा कि वे सभी चीज़ों के नाशकर्ता हैं। *कालोऽस्मि लोकक्षयकृत प्रवृद्धो*: "मैं काल को निगलने वाला संसार हूँ। मैं "हम भगवान की इस तरह की परिभाषा को इतनी आसानी से स्वीकार करने के लिए तैयार नहीं होंगे।" यदि कोई ऐसा कहता है "तुम सबको निगलने आया हूँ। सबका नाश करने आया, तो हम उसे परमेश्वर नहीं मान सकते हम सोचेंगे कि वह कोई - बहुत ही भयानक और भविष्यसूचक चीज़ है।

भगवान की श्रेष्ठताएँ क्रमशः उनकी श्रेष्ठता की विविधताओं में वर्णित की गई हैं। सबसे सुंदर वस्तुएँ, सबसे शक्तिशाली वस्तुएँ, सबसे वीरतापूर्ण कार्य, और जो कुछ भी ज्ञान और शक्ति में मानव मन की समझ से परे हैं, उसे आमतौर पर भगवान की विभूति माना जाता है। जबकि यह सच है कि भगवान की महिमा हर छोटी चीज़ में मौजूद है, और ऐसा कुछ भी नहीं है जहाँ उनकी उपस्थिति किसी न किसी रूप में महसूस न हो, हमारी संतुष्टि के लिए यह कहा जाता है कि जो हमारे ज्ञान और शक्ति से परे हैं, उसे हमें अपनी पूजा, आराधना और सम्मान के लिए भगवान की महिमा के रूप में मानना चाहिए। हम दुनिया में होने वाली घटनाओं को देखकर कई बार हैरान हो जाते हैं। हम स्तब्ध और घबरा जाते हैं। सृष्टि का आश्चर्य केवल सूर्य या चंद्रमा के उदय होने, सौरमंडल के अस्तित्व और पंचतत्व द्वारा दुनिया के निर्माण तक ही सीमित नहीं है। यह हमारे अपने छोटे जीवन के दैनिक अस्तित्व में छोटी-छोटी चीज़ों में भी मौजूद-

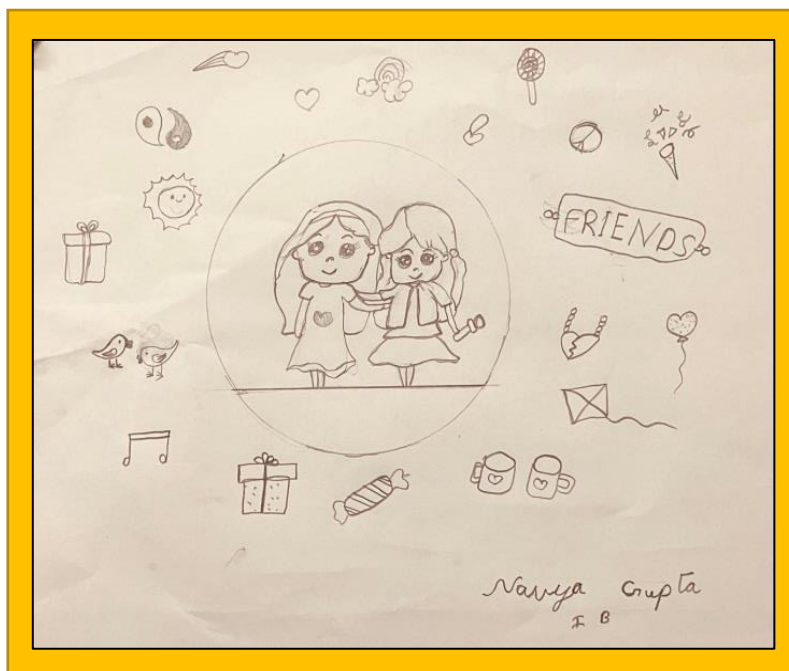
