SCHOOL DISCIPLINE

"Discipline is the refining fire by which talent becomes ability"

Inculcating discipline amongst the students is the most significant aspect of education and it is the high road to pride, self-esteem and personal satisfaction of an individual student. It is a joint endeavour of the school and the parents for which certain norms must be observed by the students.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

'Instilling values in a child is a joint responsibility of the school and parents'

1. Parents are requested to read the contents of the School Almanac carefully and make sure that their child abides by the rules and regulations laid down by the school.
2. Parents must go through the school calendar carefully and make a note of important dates, events, especially the PTMs, tests and examinations.
3. A permanent mobile number of the parents must be registered with school on which SMS and other alerts may be sent. In case of any change of number, the parents must notify the same in writing within three days.
4. Parents to ensure that the perforated sheet (Student's Personal Record), duly filled in and signed by them is to be sent to the class teacher on the due date.
5. Parents are requested to come along with the Parent Card when they come to pick up their children from the school.
6. Parents to ensure that no phone calls for any teacher or student are made during regular school hours. However, in case of any urgency, a message may be communicated at the school reception.
7. To avoid any untoward incident, parents must ensure that proper verification of driver is done, in case of independent transport arrangements; otherwise they themselves will be liable for the same.
8. Parents to ensure that the report, test paper and teacher's remark in the Almanac are duly signed by them so that they are aware of the progress of their child.
9. Parents are requested to attend Parent Teacher Meeting (PTM) and visit teachers whenever requested, for any discussion about their child.

10. Parents are requested not to send their ward to school in case he/she is not feeling well. A proper application for medical leave must be submitted in writing by the parents.
11. Parents must keep a check that their ward attends the school in proper uniform, even on PTM days and on birthdays from classes VI onwards.
12. Parents to ensure that their ward does not wear fancy shoes and jewellery and to note that keeping unkempt and unruly hair (streaking/highlighting) is not permitted in school.
13. Parents are requested to make prior appointments with the staff members. During regular school hours, meeting with the teachers and entering any of the classrooms is not permissible.
14. Parents to have a note that for the safety of your ward, no stranger is allowed to meet him/her in school.
15. Once the student has come to the school, parents or guardians are not permitted to take him/her back during the school hours, unless there is a major emergency. In such cases, the permission of the Principal is mandatory.
16. Parents to ensure that their ward is given a lunch-box and water bottle when coming to the school. No lunch boxes or water bottles will be accepted by the school, once the student has entered the school premises.
17. To keep up with the healthy ambience of the school, parents are requested to be cordial and polite with the staff of the school even in the most taxing situations.
18. School requests the parents or guardians to maintain a proper dress code at all times while entering the school premises.
19. Fees shall be payable on their due and due dates. Due date for payment of all fees should not be ignored. In case a fee is not paid on due the date the name of the ward will be struck off the school rolls. Parents will have to seek readmission with a fine.

**STUDENTS OF THE SCHOOL ARE REQUIRED TO OBSERVE THE
FOLLOWING AND PARENTS TO KINDLY MONITOR/GUIDE:**

1. Students to wear proper and immaculate uniform prescribed by the school on all school days.
2. No one is permitted to write anything on uniform.
3. Students to attend assembly on all school days compulsorily.
4. Students to attend celebration of National Days (Republic Day and Independence Day) compulsorily.
5. In order to acquire competency in spoken English language, all students should converse in English.
6. Students to be ethical and presentable with good conduct in their classroom/school.
7. Use of indecent and foul language is forbidden. Students must always behave in the righteous manner. They must be cautious on the road. Any mode of transport entails caution, care and attention to safety rules.
8. Bunking classes or school is strictly prohibited.
9. Running and shouting in the school/ corridors is not allowed. Loitering in the office area is strictly prohibited, even during recess.
10. Any form of indiscipline on the part of a student like irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence from school, leaving the premises without permission, disobedience and any type of unruly or objectionable behavior can lead to disciplinary action which may also include his/her expulsion from the school.
11. Any mischief or notorious behavior by any student in the school premises or school conveyance (abusive language, discourtesy or disrespect to the teachers, disobedience) is intolerable.
12. Only those students who hold a valid bus pass can travel in the bus. Any unruly and indiscipline behavior while traveling in the bus will result in withdrawal of the bus facility.
13. A student should report immediately, the matter of any damage done even accidentally, to the Class Teacher/Principal.
14. Students are not allowed to carry cellular phone (Mobile Phone)/ any electronic gadgets to the school. If for some reason, on a particular day the ward is required to bring camera, CD, pen drives etc., prior written permission to be obtained from the concerned teacher.
15. Students are not allowed to bring valuables (such as jewellery, costly wristwatch, cameras, any electronic gadgets etc.).
16. Students must take care of the class/school property. Any sort of vandalism, damage to the class/school property is intolerable. All students of the class will bear the cost of the damage done to the classroom/school property, in case individuals are not identified.

17. Students must inform their parents/guardians in advance, if they are expected to reach home late after the school due to stay backs.

18. Students are not permitted to use any type of unfair means, either in a class test or examination. Any student who is found using unfair means will be punished by awarding zero in the subject with a strict warning. Repetition of the same will result in his/her expulsion from the school.

In order to maintain proper discipline in school, the system of '**Red Card**' and '**Black Card**' will be followed by the school authorities,

A. Any of the below mentioned misconduct/ misbehavior or indiscipline can lead to the student being issued a **Red Card**. '**Red Card**' duly signed by the Principal will be issued to the student in the presence of his/her parents, if he/she is found guilty of any misconduct, misbehavior or indiscipline. It will be issued by the Class Teacher for a period of three days. The card will be returned to the Class Teacher on the 4th school day duly signed by the parents of the student.

MISCONDUCT FOR ISSUING 'RED CARD'

1. Using abusive language/gestures.
2. Writing/scribbling on shirt/uniform/furniture.
3. Carrying valuables/ costly articles (such as jewellery, costly wristwatch, cameras, any electronic gadgets etc.)
4. Carrying an amount exceeding Rs.100/- to the school.
5. Spreading rumours or teasing others.
6. Constantly interrupting the teaching process and indulging in rude and unacceptable behavior in the class and school premises.
7. Shortage of attendance (less than 75%).

B. Any of the below mentioned misconduct/ misbehavior or indiscipline can lead to the student being issued a **Black Card**. **Also three Red Cards issued to a particular student will lead to one Black Card and suspension of one week from the class.**

'**Black Card**' duly signed by the Principal will be issued to the student in the presence of his/her parents, if he/she is found guilty of any misconduct, misbehavior or indiscipline. It will be issued by the Class Teacher for a period of five days. The card will be returned to the Class Teacher on the 6th school day duly signed by the parents of the student.

MISCONDUCT FOR ISSUING 'BLACK CARD'

1. Damaging school property.
2. Bunking classes.
3. Bringing a cell phone, iPad, iPod, or PSP to school.
4. Use of violence in any form.
5. Damaging, scribbling or tearing pages from library books, text books and workbooks.
6. Misconduct, indiscipline and misbehavior in school transport.
7. Bullying and gross misconduct of any kind by a student with fellow schoolmate(s).
8. Bringing sharp and injury causing articles such as knife, scissors and paper cutters to school.
In case a student has to bring scissors or paper cutter for art and craft work, he/she is responsible for its safe use, failing which will lead to issue of Black Card.
9. Bringing or consuming prohibited substances in school premises will lead to issuance of a Black Card and suspension for a period of two weeks from the school.
10. Using Holi colours, bursting crackers will lead to suspension for a period of two weeks from the school.
11. Issuance of two Black Cards will lead to immediate expulsion from the school.
12. Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.
13. Propagating communal/caste feeling amongst the students.
14. Association with banned organizations.

In case of any violation or breach of code of conduct, a student is liable for disciplinary action as per Conduct rules for students and as per CBSE affiliation bye laws.

GRIEVANCE CELL CHILD ABUSE MONITORING POLICY

BEHAVIOUR PROTOCOLS FOR CHILDREN

1. Respect all staff, teachers, parents and outsiders.
2. All relevant information should always be given to the concerned staff.
3. Share information and learning with other children.
4. Never physically assault or sexually abuse another child. Never tease another child or call out nicknames.
5. Never threaten another child.
6. Never spread rumours about another child, or details about the child which could be socially humiliating.
7. Never force another child to give away his/her personal belongings.
8. Never use abusive language.

GRIEVANCE CELL-CHILD ABUSE MONITORING COMMITTEE (CAMC)

1. Students in school or their representatives can make individual requests or complaints in person or through school email id principal@bmlgreenmedows.com to the Principal of the institution.
2. Students at school can also notify complaints or any concerns regarding their treatment or conditions directly to the Grievance Cell. The members of Grievance Cell (CAMC) for the academic session 2026-27

3. The CAMC will appoint a person responsible for attending to all complaints brought before it.
4. School will also intimate the child or his/her representative/parents/guardian as per school records, of the offence and the reporting procedure to be undertaken by School within 24 hours.
5. School will initiate an enquiry, in accordance with the Child Protection Policy of the school, within 24 hours after the incident has been reported.
6. A report shall be prepared by the school upon immediate conclusion of the enquiry or within 15 days, whichever is earlier, with a copy being given to the child or his/her representative/parent/guardian.

TRANSPORT RULES

1. The school makes transport arrangements for the children through its own fleet of buses; unauthorized travelling in the buses is viewed as a serious offence and will lead to suitable disciplinary action.
2. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school by ensuring that their children travelling in the buses report at their embarking points well on time, carry their identity card with them all the time and behave in a disciplined way, in the interest of their own safety as well as that of the other users.
3. The bus drivers are authorized to stop the bus only at the designated stops. The bus will not wait for latecomers.
4. In case of any problem or any mishap, the parents are advised to avoid any altercation with drivers and conductors. They should immediately contact the school authorities on the phone numbers given on the bus, or the phone numbers given in the Almanac. The School will ensure appropriate action in such circumstances. For information related to their ward and the academic process, timing on working days, they should contact the school directly.
5. In case there is a genuine grievance, it should be submitted in writing to the School transport manager, for appropriate action.
6. The school transport and bus stops will be decided by the school transport manager in consultation with the Principal. Please remember that it is not possible to cater to individual requirements at the cost of time and distance.
7. In case of change of residence, written application along with a proof of residence must be submitted in advance, at least 15 days before the bus stop or route of a student can be changed.
8. The school transport service may only be opted for as a yearly pass payable in 11 monthly installments. The transport service cannot be discontinued in the middle of a session as the school arranges number of buses at start of session based on number of students going to utilize bus service.
9. The transport fees may be increased in the middle of the session in case of an increase in fuel prices or any other direct costs to run the transport system.
10. Students up to Class III shall be handed over to parents/guardians/ authorized persons only. Parents are requested to be personally present at the bus stop to drop and receive their ward on time.
11. The school may withdraw transport service from a locality at any time for any reason that may prohibit the school transport from reaching to or travelling through an area. This is to ensure students' safety and punctuality.
12. In case of discontinuation of bus services, parents must collect the **Application Form for Withdrawal of School Transport** from the reception and submit it after filling it out at least one month in advance. Under no circumstances will the form be handed over to the student.

Do's and Don'ts

- Behave in a courteous manner. Be seated when the bus is in motion. All safety rules should be strictly adhered to.
- Unruly behavior, tearing of seat covers, breaking window panes or related offences will result in heavy penalty and withdrawal of bus facility.
- Student should not throw any trash/food inside or outside the bus. Follow the instruction of the bus attendant. He/ She has the authority to report any offence to the principal immediately.

Note:

Bus facility shall be withdrawn by 1st day of next month if dues are not cleared of preceding month. (eg. Dues not cleared in April then school bus will be withdrawn with effect from 1st May.)

ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING - ERP

The school makes use of the ERP Portal (Entab) to enhance the efficiency and organization of several key academic and administrative functions. The portal helps in managing important aspects of student information, including:

1. **Student Profiles:** The ERP system stores and organizes individual student details, such as personal information and academic records. This centralizes all data, making it easily accessible and updatable by authorized personnel.
2. **Fee Records:** The portal tracks student fee payments and outstanding balances, allowing for transparent financial records. Parents can view fee status, upcoming due dates, and payment history, ensuring clarity in financial matters.
3. **Attendance:** The system keeps a record of student attendance, automatically updating when a student is marked present or absent. This makes it easier for parents and teachers to track and manage attendance data.
4. **Assessments:** The ERP system also helps in monitoring students' academic progress through their assessment results. Teachers can input grades, and parents can access these assessments to stay updated on their child's performance.
